### TREASURERS REPORT

- Last year the hall made a profit, it was agreed to keep £13k in the bank for emergencies [2 years costs] leaving a potential of £6k to invest in hall improvements.
   The committee agreed to spend £5k of this, focusing on seating, lighter tables and improving storage of the staging / tables /seating which in turn will benefit the bowlers and casual use of the hall.
- Was agreed to create a long term "Wishlist" of items we think the hall could benefit from – Alex to create and circulate

### **Better Communication with members**

- It was agreed to post the end of year accounts online on the yellow card website. These records are public domain and will be pulled from company's house
- It was agreed to post the chairman's reports online, Alex Wil redact any names before doing this to comply with GDPR
- A rolling 6 months of committee minutes will be held online, names again redacted.
- The agreed purpose of this is to get community
- engagement with what is covered

#### **Finances**

## Covered in treasury report but plan is

- buy another 30 padded chairs, and new style rack
- keep about 18-20 of the old grey chairs
- donate the rest of the old chairs and trolleys to charity
- use the space by the mixing deck to store 12 Staging units vertically [making it easier for the bowlers]
- buy 10 folding tables [used for food events like burns night pot luck ] etc
- store the new folding tables in the mixing deck space
- keep the new trolley of chairs in mixing deck space
- look at cost of trestles for bowlers
- steps for staging
- discuss/agree at next meeting

### **Photo Exhibition**

 Alex discussed the photo exhibition, £750 has been paid to the SCIO to cover printing and framing costs, a website is being setup to allow people to submit the work.
 Closer to the event volunteers will be asked to sit in the hall when the exhibition is on. Alex to create the images and arrange printing

water quality and the implications of this, Barry confirmed that as the water is
untreated is will be considered not fit for drinking water. Murry raised concerns on
the public liability related to falling masonry and long-term costs of repairs. Guy will
be contacted to say the committee agree in principle to taking ownership of the asset
[legally] but want to know the plan for long term maintenance and plan for the water
testing
